How to Write a Thank You Note

Sentence #2: Include a nice detail that compliments the person's thoughtfulness.

Sentence #3: Give an example of how you will use it.

I have them on my dining room table..., I can't wait to use the clutch this fall...We enjoyed the banana bread all weekend...

Sentence #4: If the situation warrants it, express your gratitude for the relationship.

We could not have gotten through these past few weeks without you...I am so blessed to have a neighbor like you...

Tips for Writing a Thank You Note

- **Be timely.** Write a thank you note as soon as possible after receiving the gift, but late is always better than never.
- **Be succinct.** Four to five sentences is perfectly sufficient for a thank you note.
- **Be sincere.** Your level of effusiveness should align with how well you know the person.
- A thank you note is not required for a thank you gift or note. While thoughtful, it is not expected.
- Your stationery does not need to say "thank you" on it. Personalized stationery is just as thoughtful.

How to Write a Sympathy Note

Greeting: Dear {Name}

Sentence #1: Give sympathy for the loss of their loved one.

I am so sorry about the loss/passing of...My heart just breaks for you and your family during this difficult time...

Sentence #2: Acknowledge what a special person he/she was.

I know you and your mom shared a special bond, with memories you will carry for the rest of your life...Your daughter was an amazing person..

Sentence #3: If possible, recall a memory of this person. If you did not know the person personally, this section can be omitted.

Your father was one of the kindest gentlemen with the best sense of humor something he clearly passed down to you...I remember when...

Sentence #4: As generic as it might be, remind them they are in your thoughts or prayers.

You will be in my prayers during this difficult time.

Tips for Writing a Sympathy Note

- **Be sincere, yet succinct.** Your purpose is to simply give your condolences and honor the life of the person who has passed away.
- Avoid phrases like:
 - "This was God's will."
 - "He/she is in a better place."
 - "At least he lived a long life."
 - "You will most likely remarry and be happy again someday."
 - "I know how you feel." (Keep the focus on the recipient)
